**Exodus 20:12** <sup>12</sup> Honour thy father and thy mother: that thy days may be long upon the land which the LORD thy God giveth thee.

**Proverb 4:1** — Hear, ye children, the instruction of a father, and attend to know understanding.

**Proverb 14:26** — In the fear of the LORD is strong confidence: and his children shall have a place of refuge.

**Proverb 17:6** — Children's children are the crown of old men; and the glory of children are their fathers.

**Proverbs 19:18** <sup>18</sup> Chasten thy son while there is hope, and let not thy soul spare for his crying.

**Proverb 20:11** — Even a child is known by his doings, whether his work be pure, and whether it be right.

**Proverbs 22:6** <sup>6</sup> Train up a child in the way he should go: and when he is old, he will not depart from it. **Proverb 22:15** — Foolishness is bound in the heart of a child; but the rod of correction shall drive it far from him.

**Proverb 23:13** — Withhold not correction from the child: for if thou beatest him with the rod, he shall not die

**Luke 18:16** - <sup>15</sup> And they brought unto him also infants, that he would touch them: but when his disciples saw it, they rebuked them. But Jesus called them unto him, and said, Suffer little **children** to come unto me, and forbid them not: for of such is the kingdom of God.

## TRIUMPHAL ENTRY

**Luke 19:41** <sup>41</sup> And when he was come near, he beheld the city, and wept over it, <sup>42</sup> Saying, If thou hadst known, even thou, at least in this thy day, the things which belong unto thy peace! but now they are hid from thine eyes. <sup>43</sup> For the days shall come upon thee, that thine enemies shall cast a trench about thee, and compass thee round, and keep thee in on every side, <sup>44</sup> And shall lay thee even with the ground, and thy children within thee; and they shall not leave in thee one stone upon another; because thou knewest not the time of thy visitation.

**Matthew 10:21** - And the brother shall deliver up the brother to death, and the father the child: and the **children** shall rise up against their parents, and cause them to be put to death.

**Matthew 24:19** <sup>19</sup> And woe unto them that are with child, and to them that give suck in those days! <sup>20</sup> But pray ye that your flight be not in the winter, neither on the sabbath day: <sup>21</sup> For then shall be great tribulation, such as was not since the beginning of the world to this time, no, nor ever shall be.

**Jeremiah 16:6** The word of the LORD came also unto me, saying, <sup>2</sup> Thou shalt not take thee a wife, neither shalt thou have sons or daughters in this place. <sup>3</sup> For thus saith the LORD concerning the sons and concerning the daughters that are born in this place, and concerning their mothers that bare them, and concerning their fathers that begat them in this land; <sup>4</sup> They shall die of grievous deaths; they shall not be lamented; neither shall they be buried; but they shall be as dung upon the face of the earth:

**Jeremiah 6:16** <sup>16</sup> Thus saith the LORD, Stand ye in the ways, and see, and ask for the old paths, where is the good way, and walk therein, and ye shall find rest for your souls. But they said, We will not walk therein. <sup>17</sup> Also I set watchmen over you, saying, Hearken to the sound of the trumpet. But they said, We will not hearken.

**Isaiah 60:1** <sup>1</sup> Arise, shine; for thy light is come, and the glory of the LORD is risen upon thee. <sup>2</sup> For, behold, the darkness shall cover the earth, and gross darkness the people: but the LORD shall arise upon thee, and his glory shall be seen upon thee.

**Ephesians 6:4** Children, obey your parents in the Lord: for this is right. <sup>2</sup> Honour thy father and mother; which is the first commandment with promise; <sup>3</sup> That it may be well with thee, and thou mayest live long on the earth. <sup>4</sup> And, ye fathers, provoke not your children to wrath: but bring them up in the nurture and admonition of the Lord.
