A Season of Rest Mark 6:30

Many are slowing down for various reasons. A lot of us choose to slow down the pace during certain seasons, especially summers. Our family life or our schedules are busy with projects and travel. Work stands alone. Remember, Man (males) were cursed to work (Genesis 3:17). However, God also gave us an order to rest (Exodus 20:9, 10). In fact, God noted longer life with "with reason" (Psalms 90:10).

We may ache physically and need the downtime to let our bodies mend. Others of us ache emotionally and need to pull away so our hearts can heal. Some of us are attending to the aid of our love ones, which can be fatiguing. Maybe, the Lord is using us to help provide strength to them during their trial. Jesus noted to send the disciples away alone as He knew they needed some down time away from Him. But there is another type of rest we often need. That is rest from trials. As Christians we will see many tribunals as noted by Jesus (Matt 24:9-13). Jesus said my yoke is easy and my burden is light (Matt 11:30).
